


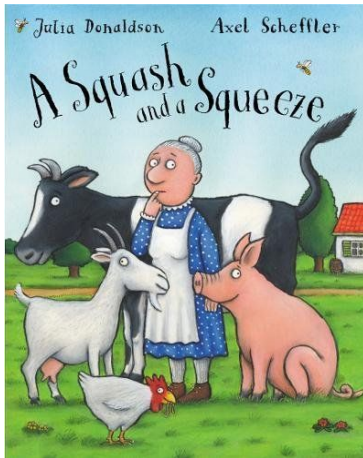




### Year 1 Recommended Reading List

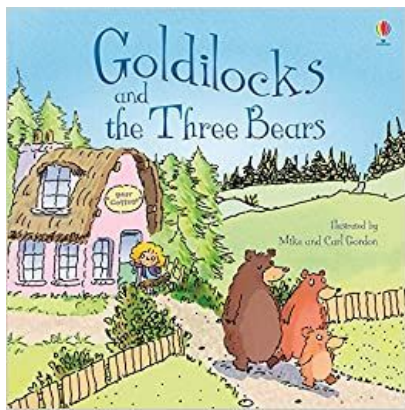

A Squash and a Squeeze is a picture book about an old lady who requires more room in her house. With the help of an old man and a few farmyard animals a rather unconventional solution is provided.



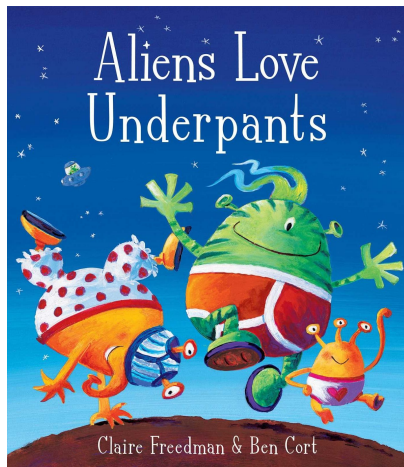
### Goldilocks and the Three Bears

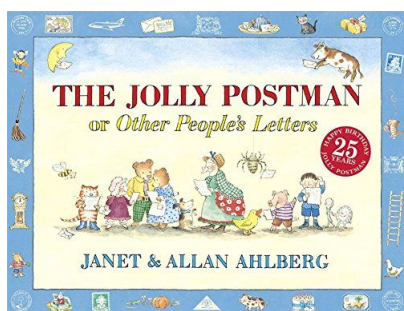
### Supertato

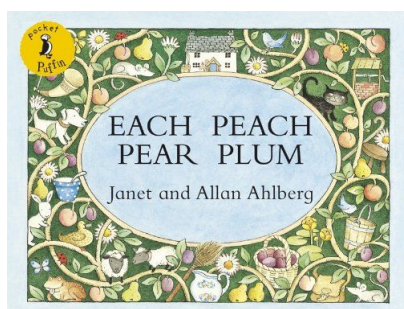
#### Aliens Love Underpants

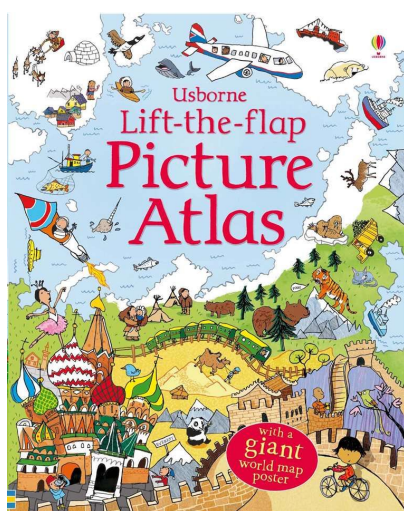
#### The Jolly Postman
